Within twenty-five years of Spain's discovery of the island of Hispaniola, the native Amerindians were exterminated. Spain ceded the western third of the island to France and this became what is now Haiti. As a French colony, Haiti was prosperous, exporting timber and sugar. African slaves were imported as laborers. In 1791, the slaves revolted against the French and dedicated their country to Satan as a way to oppose the religion of their oppressors. ~ Seventy-five percent of Roman Catholics in Haiti also practice voodoo, witchcraft and West African spiritism. Evangelical Christians stand openly against the voodoo culture in Haiti.

Our world is in desperate need for people who believe in Jesus to **believe** Him—the Living Word! (Hebrews 1:1–3)

- for renewed belief ~ "This is what my Father wants: that anyone who sees the Son and BELIEVES trusts who He is and what He does and then aligns with Him will enter real life, eternal life." John 6:40
