WEEK ONE: A CHURCH AWAKENED

Sept. 1 ~ WAKE UP!

Sept. 3 ~ CONSECRATE & SANCTIFY YOURSELVES

Sept. 13 ~ GLORIFY THE SON

Christ made us right with God; he made us pure and holy, and he freed us from sin. Therefore, if you want to boast, boast only about the Lord. *1 Cor 1:30-31 ~ Gal 2:20, 1 Pet 4:12-13*

Sept. 14 ~ GLORIFY THE HOLY SPIRIT

Wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. All of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.
